Sir: The health of the State during the past two years has been threatened by no unusual epidemic. Smallpox, which has given us a good deal of concern during the past eight years almost disappeared. For a period of eighteen consecutive months our chief city was wholly exempt. But four cases occurred in Maryland in 1905 down to December 10th, when a few cases appeared in Baltimore and its environs, and the year ends with a renewed menace, arising in the State of Virginia; not serious enough, however, to justify any alarm. During the year 1905, Typhoid Fever has been unusually prevalent. The mortality for this year will exceed that for 1904, when 508 deaths were charged to typhoid fever. The increased prevalence in 1905, included several institutional outbreaks. The typhoid history of 1905 has strongly stimulated public interest in the supervision of water supplies, and has emphasized need of...



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
