Over 500 square miles of park land is covered in glacier, and much of the rest of the park can be classified as early-succession, postglacial environment. These recently disturbed landscapes are highly susceptible to invasion by a number of non-native, invasive plant species which can out-compete native species and have a negative impact on natural ecosystem diversity and processes.
